Who should attend?

This course is suitable for anyone who is required to use a Overhead Crane in their daily working duties.

Course Aims & Objectives

The purpose of this course is to give delegates the skills required to safely operate a Overhead Crane. It covers the Law, maintenance of the crane and manual checks to ensure safety.

By the end of the course delegates will:

- Have a thorough understanding of how to successfully control and manoeuvre the crane
- Be able to inspect the crane to ensure safe use
- Understand all of the regulations required to ensure safety in the workplace
