



PASMA – Mobile Access Towers for Users

Who should attend?

Those who need to erect, dismantle and inspect mobile access towers safely. Since the assembly and use of mobile towers can be physically demanding, users should be physically fit, in good health and should, generally, not have problems with eyesight or hearing, heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, fear of heights / vertigo, giddiness / difficulty with balance, impaired limb function, alcohol or drug dependence or psychiatric illness.

To provide delegates with an understanding of current relevant legislation and be able to dismantle, erect and inspect mobile access towers safely, as per the manufacturer's instructions.
